

STATEMENT FROM WASHINGTON'S NATIONAL PARK FUND REGARDING THE 2025 FEDERAL GOVERNMENT SHUTDOWN

SEATTLE (October 6, 2025) – During the ongoing federal government shutdown, national park units across the country — including Mount Rainier, North Cascades, and Olympic National Parks — may experience limited services, reduced access, and diminished resources. For the most up-to-date information, we encourage the public to review contingency plans at doi:gov/shutdown.

Washington's National Park Fund asks that individuals refrain from adding pressure on limited national park resources at this time. Instead, there are many ways to stay connected and show support:

- Explore local and non-federal public lands while continuing to recreate responsibly and practice Leave No Trace.
