## WASHINGTON'S NATIONAL PARK FUND HOSTS WORLD PREMIERE OF NORTH CASCADES NATIONAL PARK FILM

Join WNPF for the public film screening of "The North Cascades: An Elevated Journey"

**SEATTLE (April 5, 2024) –** Washington's National Park Fund (WNPF), the official philanthropic partner serving North Cascades National Park, as well as Mount Rainier and Olympic National Parks, invites you to witness the magic of the never-before-seen North Cascades National Park Service Complex film *The North Cascades: An Elevated Journey* at its public premiere in Burlington.

North Cascades National Park was established nearly 55 years ago on October 2, 1968, by President Lyndon B. Johnson. Protecting 789 square miles of rugged wilderness, this remote national park has welcomed a growing number of visitors over the years and saw a 33% increase in visitation in 2023.

Soar to new heights to see rarely seen footage of expansive glaciers and jagged peaks, as *The North Cascades: An Elevated Journey* travels up and over the magnificent North Cascades mountains, from the lush western slopes, across the high alpine, to the arid eastern side. This long-anticipated 18-minute film showcases awe-inspiring cinematography of the peaks, wildlife, and beauty of the North Cascades and will become the introductory film seen by millions of visitors each year at the park's North Cascades Visitor Center in Newhalem.

Be among the first to witness the interconnectedness of these diverse plant and animal ecosystems in the new film and see firsthand the profound ways they touch the lives of the people who explore this wild landscape. Following the film, hear from park leadership and those involved with the making of the film, and participate in a Q&A. Light food and beverages will be provided.
